Pre-production phase:

name	description	function/position
	will be responsible for the text.	script master
	will be responsible for the set: What can be done? What do you need?	set & props master

Production phase:

name	description	function/position
	will film.	camera operator
	will be responsible for the set and light design.	set design, light director
	will be the protagonist.	actor
	will be a hook-up.*	actor

^{*}optional, more than one possible, a hook-up is a person who send you a video and this person is edited into your video, after filming.

Post-Production phase:

name	description	function/position
	will write text to add to the	text animator
